



### **Registration Rates**

The Full Meeting registration rate includes admission into all AALS programs, except ticketed events listed below. The registration rate for the Program on the Section on Institutional Advancement is limited to use by Professional Staff, and includes only sessions from this two-day program within the Annual Meeting. Speakers and attendees who attend any sessions at the Annual Meeting are required to pay the registration fee.

### Ways to Register and Forms of Payment

Register online using our convenient <u>Individual</u> or <u>Group</u> <u>Registration</u> systems; pay with Visa, MasterCard, or AMEX. You may also register by check or credit card using a paper registration form (fax and mailing information included below). To ensure the security of payment information in accordance with Payment Card Industry Association standards, email registration is no longer available.

### **Spouse/Partner Registration**

New this year, is the addition of a spouse/partner registration rate. Your guest may use this rate as long as they are not law school faculty, staff, retired/emeritus, or a law student. Select ticketed events are also open to spouse/partner registrants with the purchase of an additional ticket, while others are limited to only law school faculty/staff.
