† Notes on Section Officer Positions per AALS Executive Committee Regulations

1. Only faculty members and professional staff of AALS member law schools may hold a position in a Section.
2. Adjunct faculty and visitors without permanent school affiliations or those not at AALS member law school may not hold section positions
3. The Section Chair can hold the position of Chair for two consecutive years within a seven year period
4. No person may serve as chair of two sections at the same time.
