SUBJECT: Different Pattern in 2013 and 2014 AALS Annual Meeting Schedules

I am writing to inform you of the schedule for the **2013 AALS Annual Meeting** in New Orleans, Louisiana, which is different than our usual pattern of days of the week. The Annual Meeting programming will start on Friday, January 4th at 2:00 pm and continue through Monday, January 7th at 5:00 pm. If you have any flexibility in your 2013 spring school calendar, we would appreciate if you would consider starting classes after Monday, January 7, 2013.

The schedule for the 2013 Annual Meeting is as follows:

- Friday, January 4th from 2:00 to 5:00 pm with Section half-day programs;
- Saturday, January 5th will be a full day of programming with four time slots of 1 ³/₄ hours from 8:30 am to 5:15 pm, followed by the First Meeting of the House of Representatives, followed by the Gala Reception;
- Sunday, January 6th will be a full day of programming with three time slots of 1 ¾ hour Section programs including the Association Luncheon, the Presidential Programs and the Second Meeting of the House of Representatives; and,
- Monday, January 7th will be a full day of programming from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm for Section half-day and full day programs, Section field trips and service projects, and the AALS Workshop on Globalizing the Curriculum.

Also, please note the dates and pattern for the **2014 Annual Meeting** in New York City, registration will open at 6pm on Thursday, January 2nd and program sessions will begin at 8:30 am on Friday, January 3rd with the final sessions of the Annual Meeting ending at 12:00 noon on Monday, January 6, 2014. Again, if you have any flexibility in your 2014 spring school calendar, we would appreciate if you would consider starting classes after Monday, January 7, 2014.
