Authors' works will be published in the spring edition of the Barry Law Review, which anticipates receiving a draft from authors in January 2019 for the editing process.

Those who are interested in presenting at the Forum without the publication commitment are also invited to submit proposals with travel being self-funded. Meals and a dinner reception will be provided on March 1.

The deadline for submission is December 31, 2018.
