Authors should include their name and contact information in their submission email but remove all identifying information from an abstract or a draft of an unpublished paper submitted. Please include the words "AALS – Sec Reg Meeting Submission" in the subject line of your submission email.

In addition, we will again hold a "New Voices in Securities Regulation" program, which will bring together junior and senior scholars in the field of securities regulation for the purpose of providing junior scholars with feedback and guidance on their draft articles. Junior scholars who are interested in participating in the program should send a draft or summary of at least five pages to either Professor Benjamin Edwards (benjamin.edwards@unlv.edu) or Professor Michael Guttentag (michael.guttentag@lls.edu) on or before **Monday, August 21, 2023**. The cover email should state the junior scholar's institution, tenure status, number of years in current position, whether the paper has been accepted for publication, and, if not, when the scholar anticipates submitting the article to law reviews. The subject line of the email should read: "AALS – Sec Reg – New Voices Submission."
