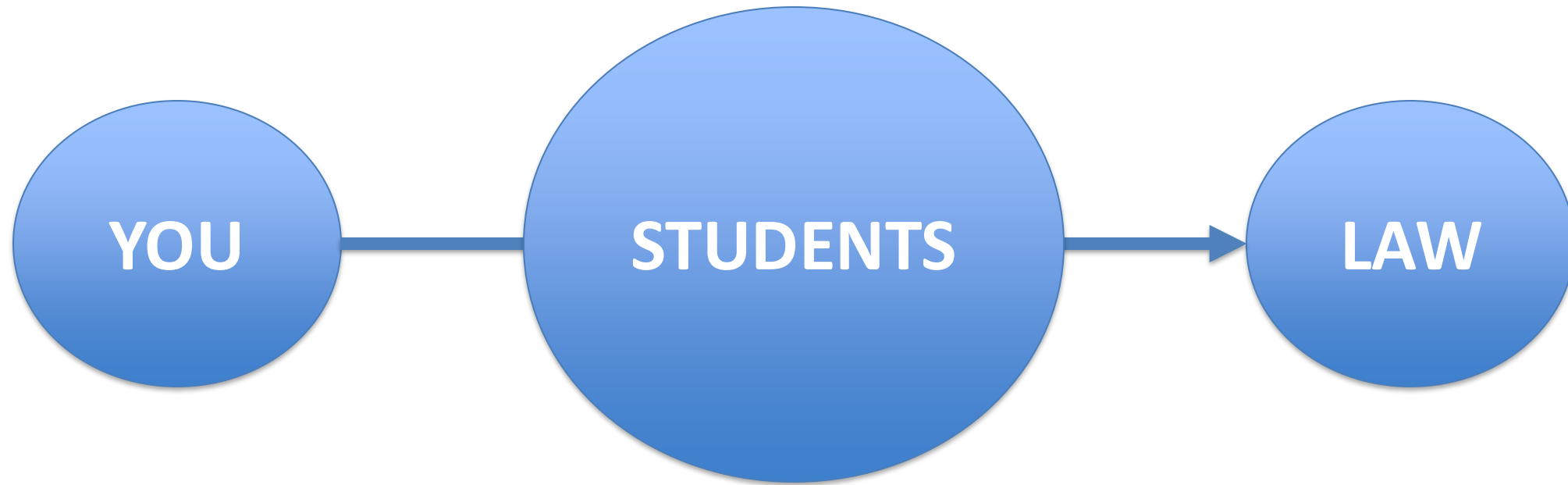

# Three roles





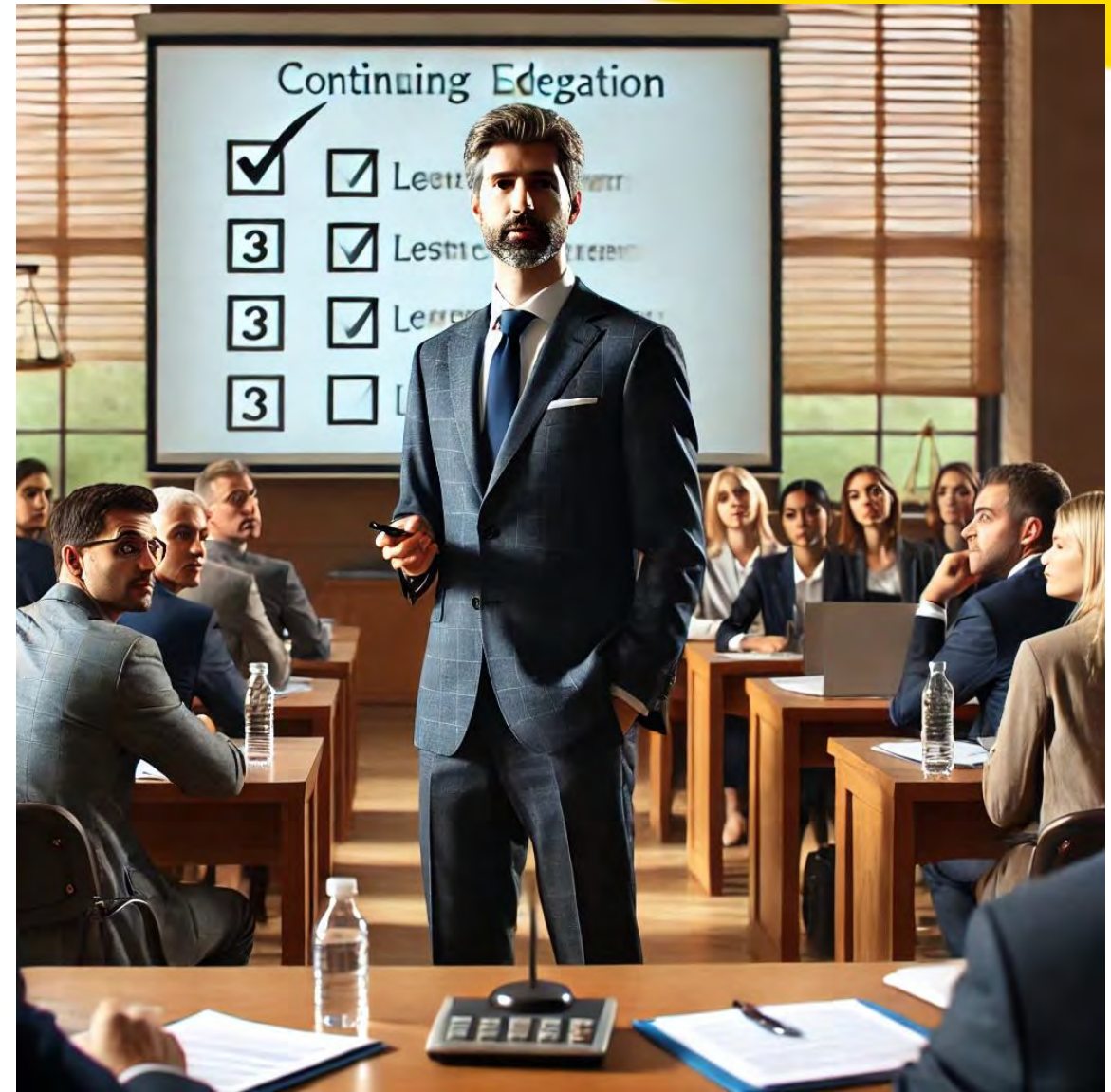
# What do you want students to learn?

- Before, during, and after
- Classroom assessment techniques

  - Polls, Quizzes
  - Minute papers
  - Skills drills
  - Reflections
  - Group assignments
