

# Six Ways Law Schools Can Promote Their Activities Through AALS

The Association of American Law Schools has several services to help law schools promote their news, events, research, and public service.

#### 1 Legal Education News

AALS compiles a <u>weekly digest of news</u> about law schools and legal education. We include news on new programs, collaborations with other schools and departments, faculty/student accomplishments, awards, clinical activities, and special events.

You or members of your staff can submit news using <u>this</u> <u>form</u>. AALS also organizes a digest of legal education related blogs posts. You can subscribe to both digests and view archived blog posts <u>here</u>.

Recent upgrades to our archive include a dedicated search for <u>news and blogs</u> and a page for legal education related <u>podcasts</u>.

## 2 Law School Calendar of Symposia

AALS hosts a regularly updated <u>list of symposia</u>, conferences, and panel discussions hosted by law schools. We also email this calendar to law faculty several times during the year. You can send us your events to promote on the calendar using <u>this form</u>.

### 3 Faculty Books

If a member of your faculty published a scholarly book during the last two years, they may submit their publication for inclusion on our listing of books by law faculty.

#### 4 Member School Highlights

In 2022, AALS launched a new feature on the AALS website and social media channels called Member School Highlights. This effort spotlights a different <u>AALS Member School</u> for a period of time and focuses on a recent program or accomplishment in order to showcase the rich variety of approaches to legal education that make up the American legal academy. ### 5 Section on Institutional Advancement

The Section on Institutional Advancement is a great way for law school professionals in alumni relations, communications, development, and external relations connect, seek advice, and share ideas.
