Adding Value to Experience

Primary Ways Teachers Provide Value by Structuring an Experiential Education Offering

- 1. **Choose subject matter** for legal work of law clinic, externship, or simulation
- 2. Choose cases or matters for clinic, or create simulations
- 3. Vet placements and field supervisors, or recruit practitioners to assist with simulation course
- 4. Train field supervisors for externships
- 5. Match students with externship placements
- 6. **Prepare activities** for class sessions

Primary Ways Teachers Provide Value During an Experiential Education Offering

- 1. Provide in-depth conceptual frameworks for individual skills
- 2. Provide intensive supervision of student preparation and performance of work
- 3. Provide specific feedback and debriefing on student performances, simulated or real
- 4. Provide opportunities for **student reflection and systemic critique** apart from feedback on performances
- 5. **Integrate** conceptual frameworks, supervision, feedback, and reflection
