

Call for Papers for Section on East Asian Law & Society Program at the 2017 AALS Annual Meeting

The Section on East Asian Law & Society is pleased to announce a Call for Papers from which presenters will be selected for the Section's program to be held during the AALS 2017 Annual Meeting in San Francisco on Saturday, January 7th, 2017. This is a "research in progress" program, and includes research that is ongoing as well as recently completed work.

Papers may be either in a short form (5,000-7,500 words) or a long form (10,000-25,000 words). Up to four papers will be selected and announced in the fall 2016. Papers will be reviewed by a committee of our Section comprised of Professors Setsuo Miyazawa (UC Hastings), Jim Feinerman (Georgetown) and Margaret Woo (Northeastern). **Papers should be submitted to Setsuo Miyazawa at miyazawa@uchastings.edu by August 31.**

The Section has arranged for selected papers to be submitted to the *University of Pennsylvania Asian Law Review* for consideration and possible publication.

Presenters will be responsible for paying the AALS meeting registration fee and hotel and travel expenses.
