Mentorship Program Description

The Criminal Justice Section Mentorship Program connects new and untenured criminal law and criminal procedure professors with more senior professors at other schools. Ideally, the senior faculty member will check in with the untenured faculty member at least once per semester, read at least one draft per year, provide teaching advice, and help the untenured faculty member meet other faculty in the field. We anticipate that the mentor will provide advice up through the junior faculty member's award of tenure.
