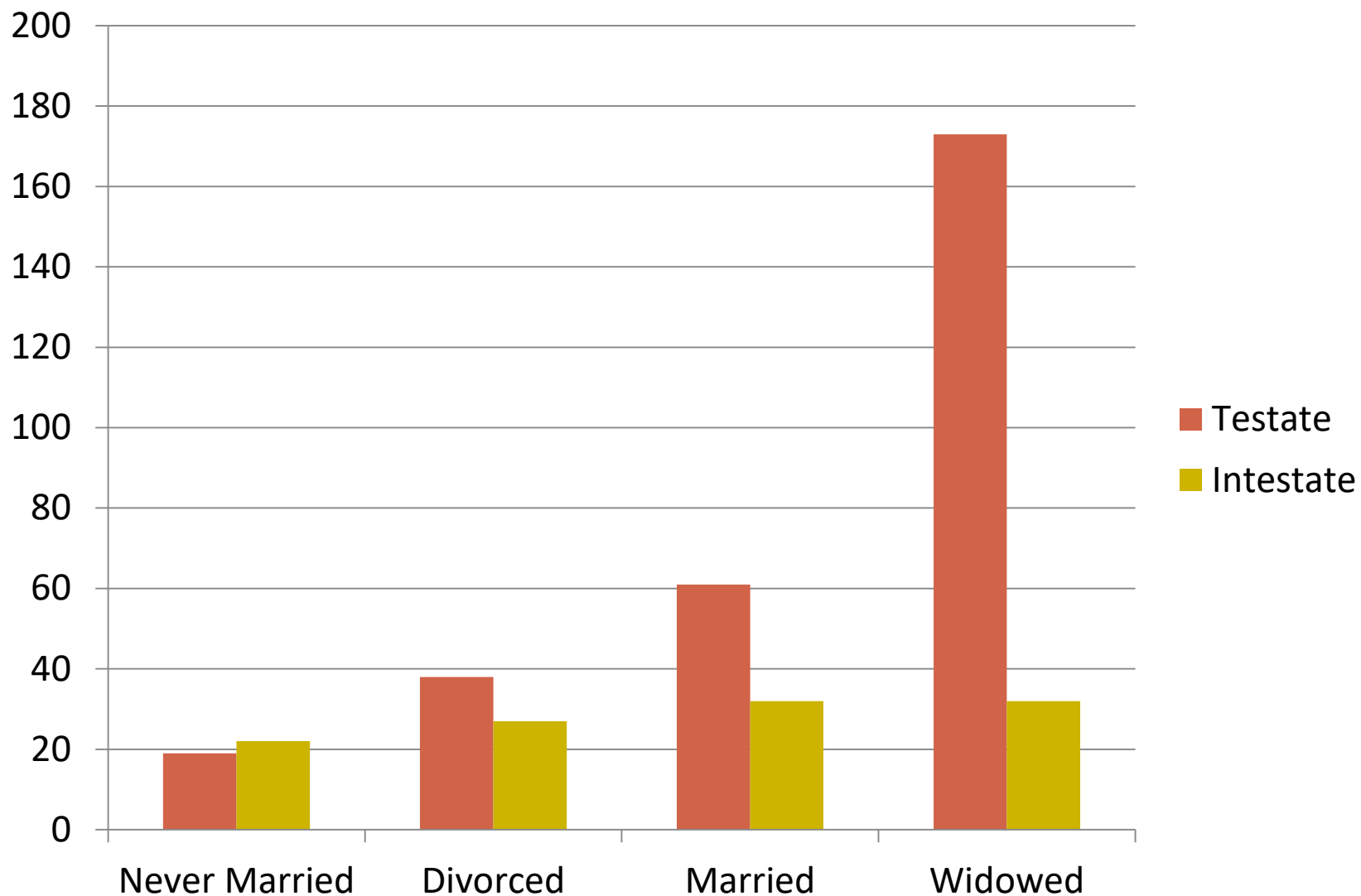

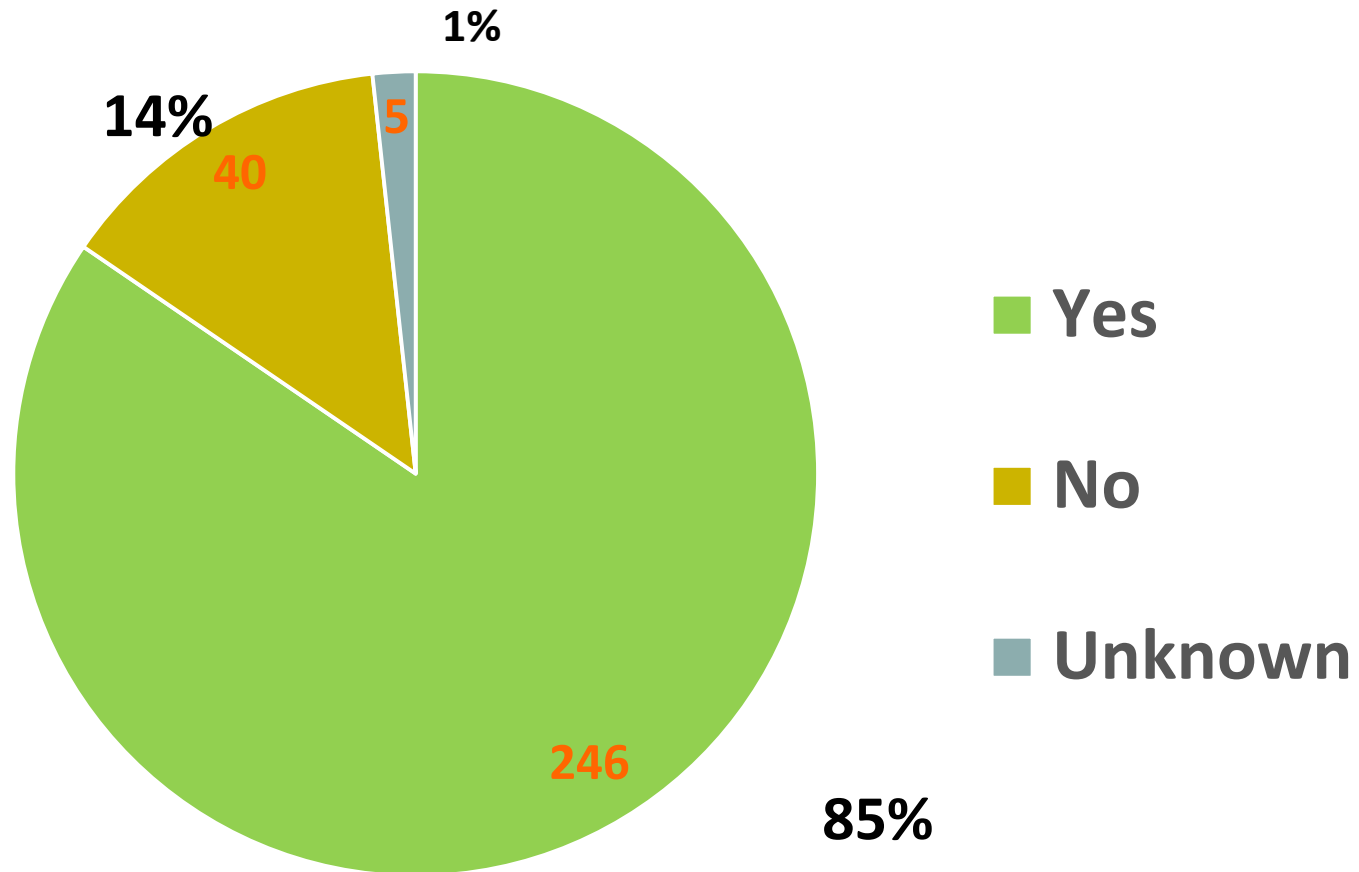

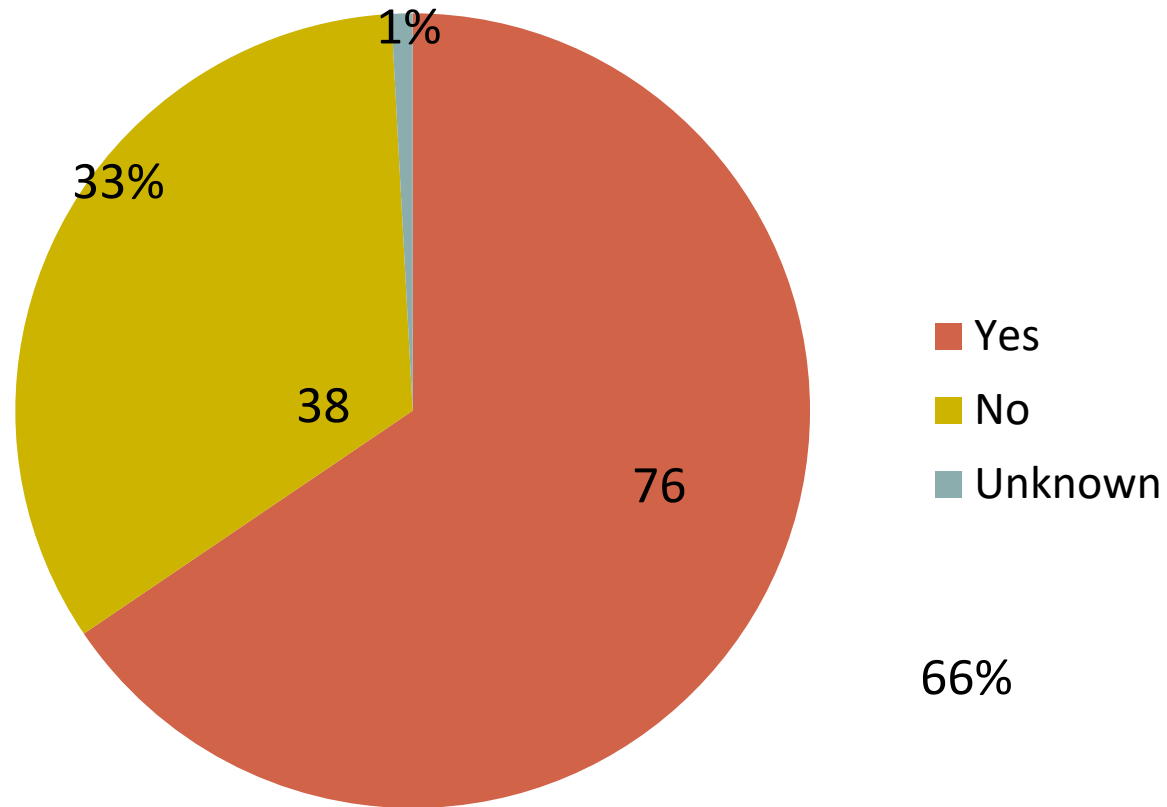

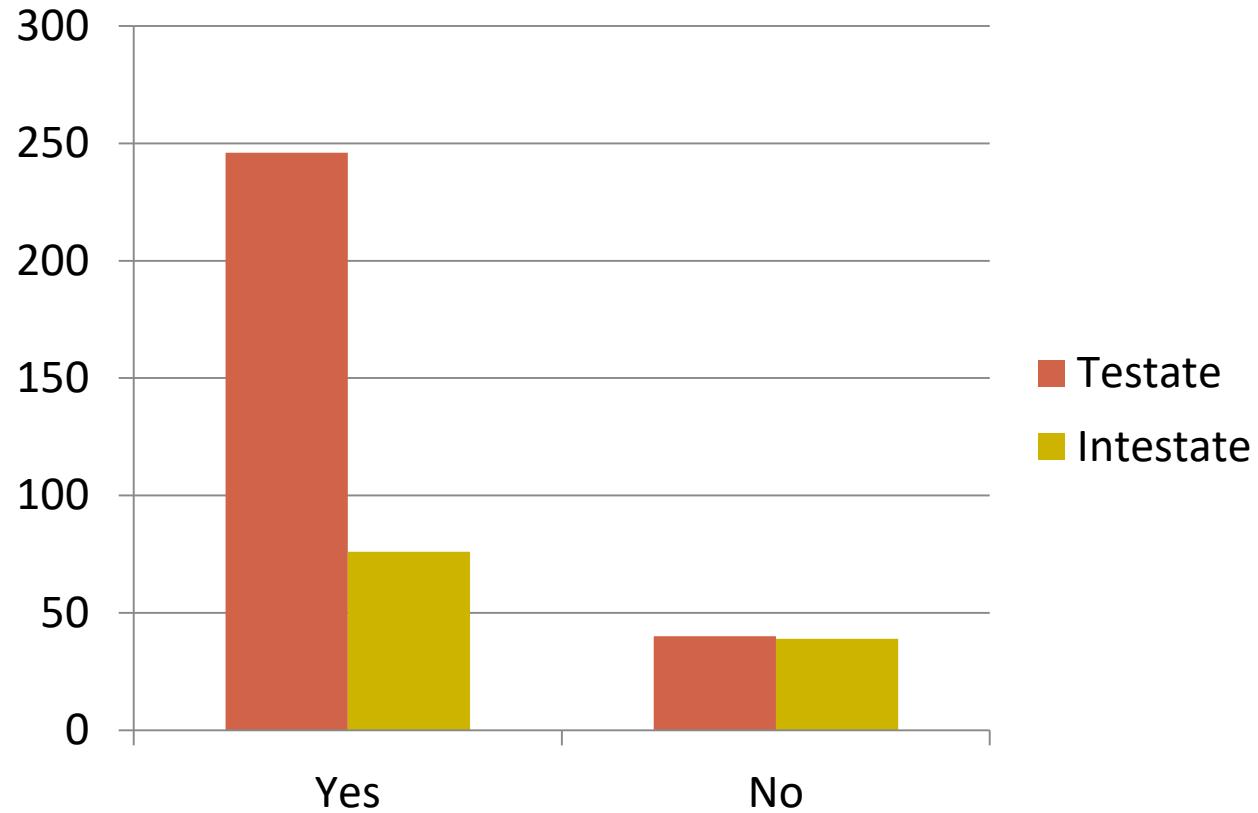

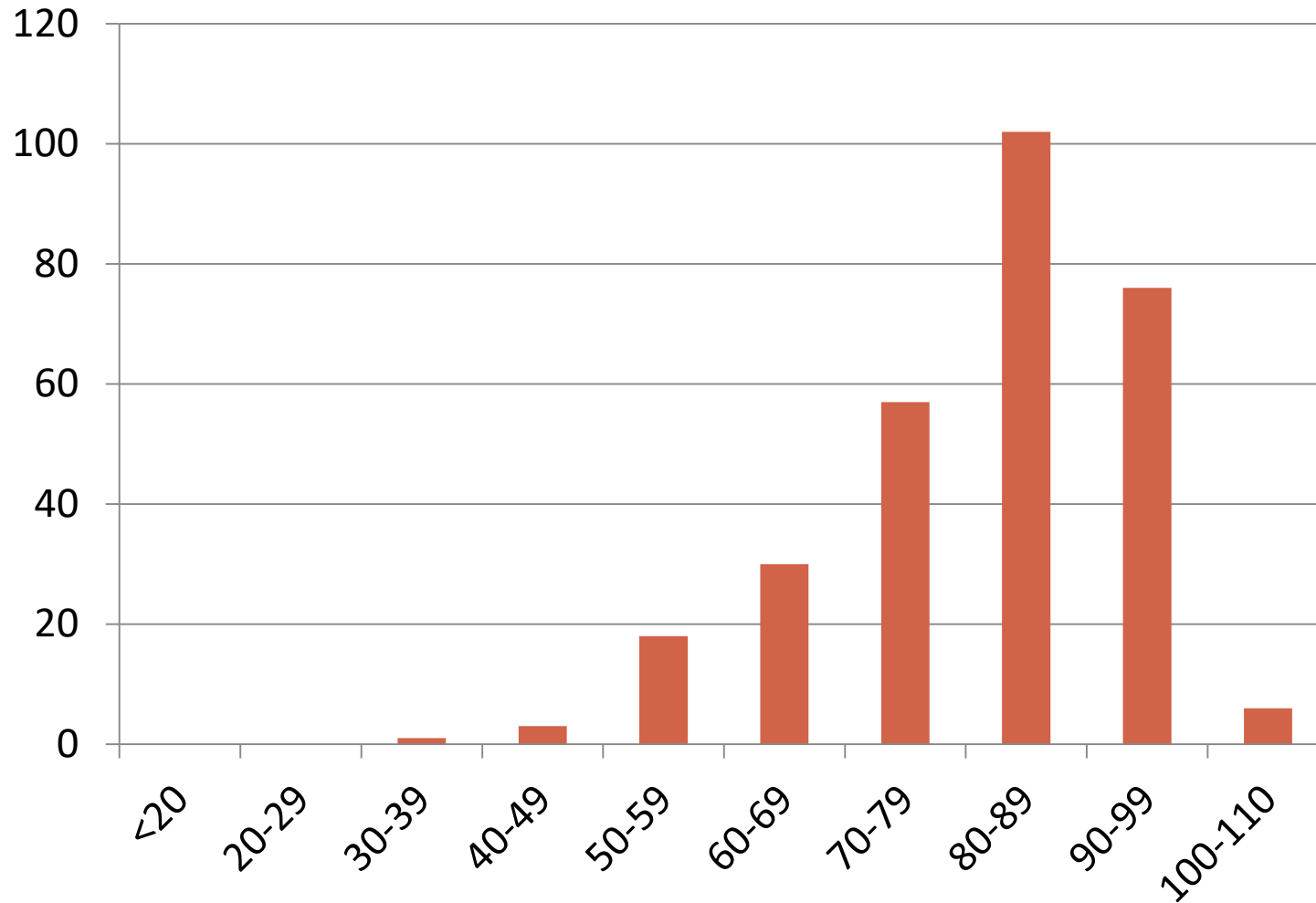

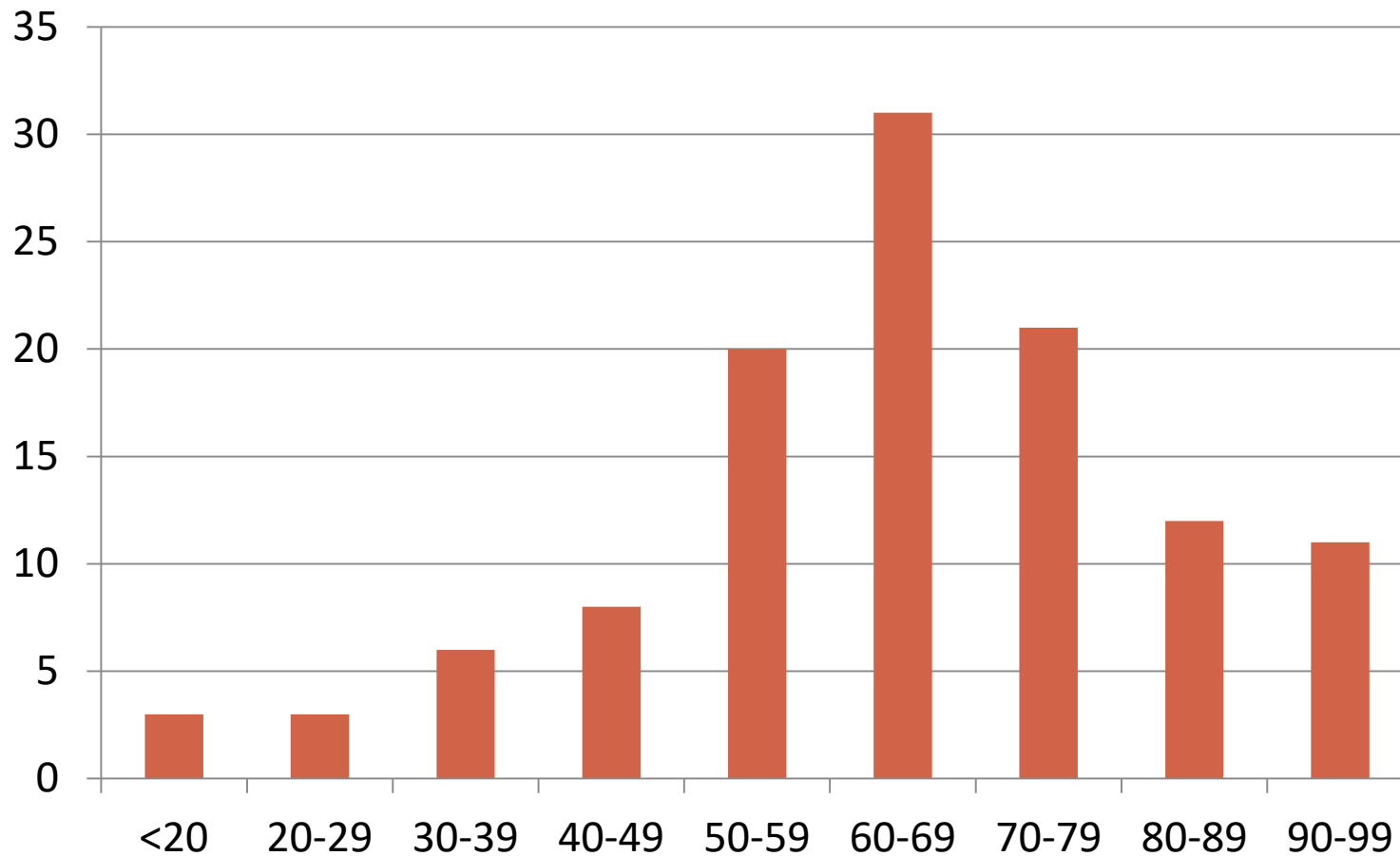

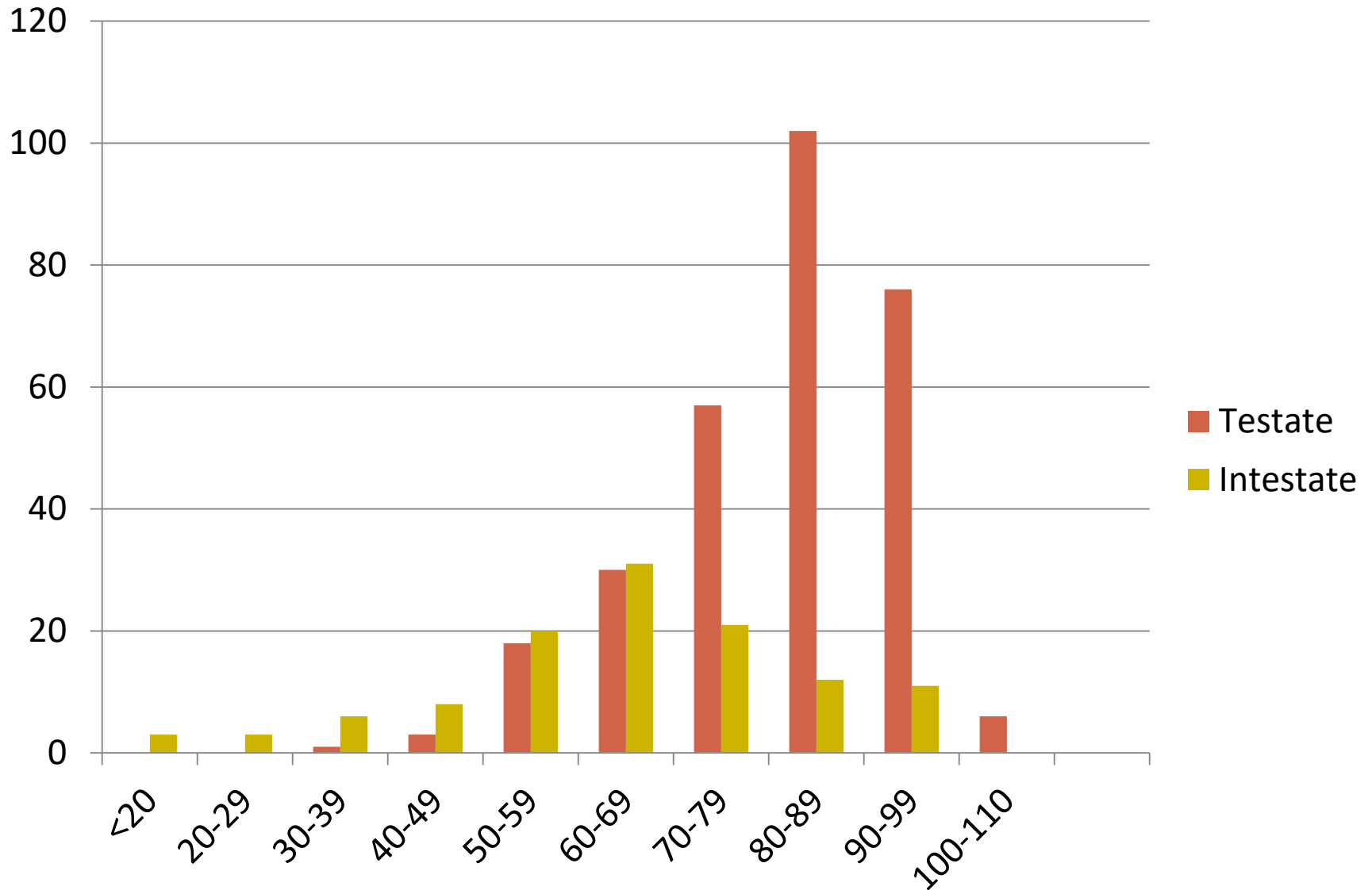
AGE OF TESTATE DECEDENTS



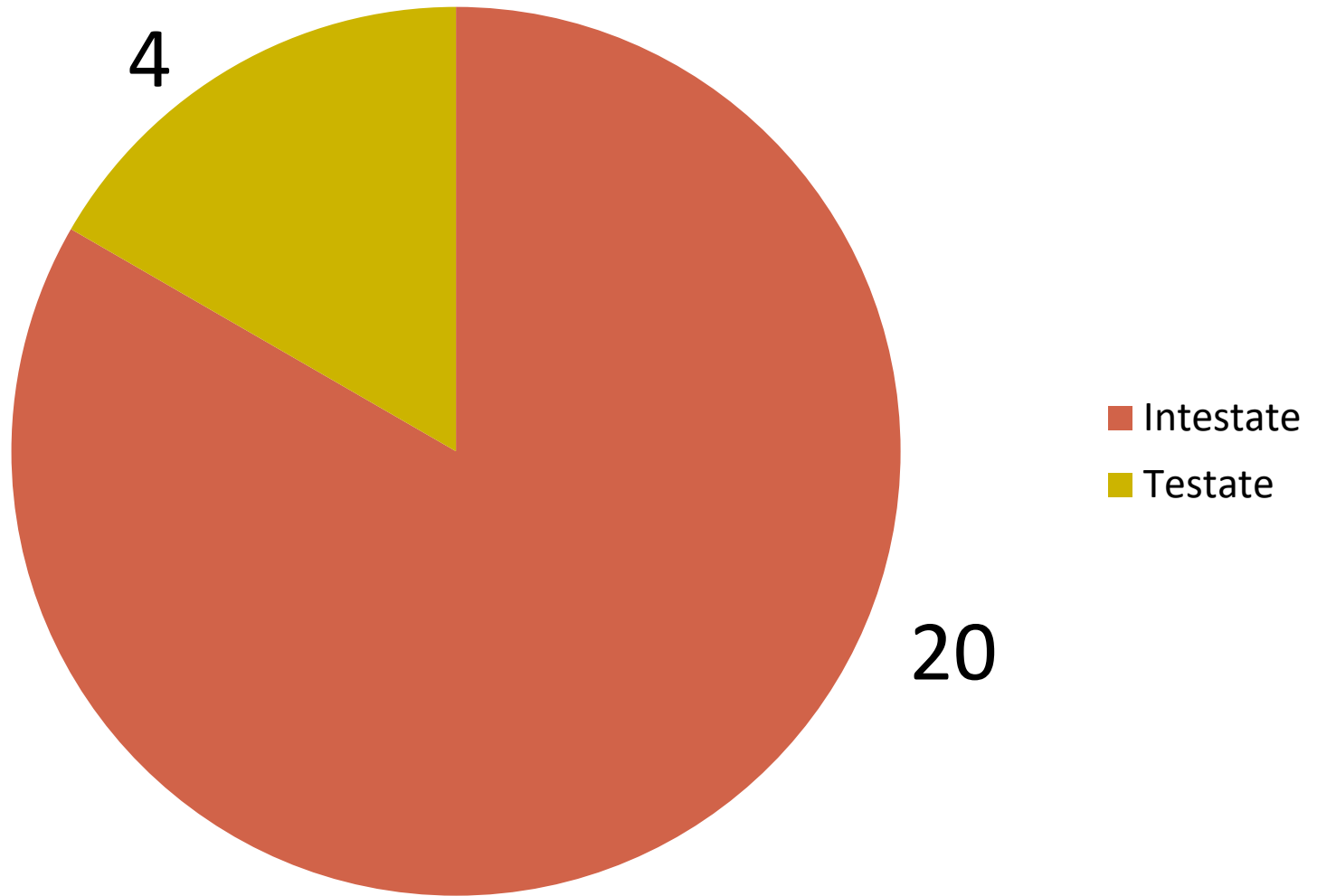
AGE OF INTESTATE DECEDENTS



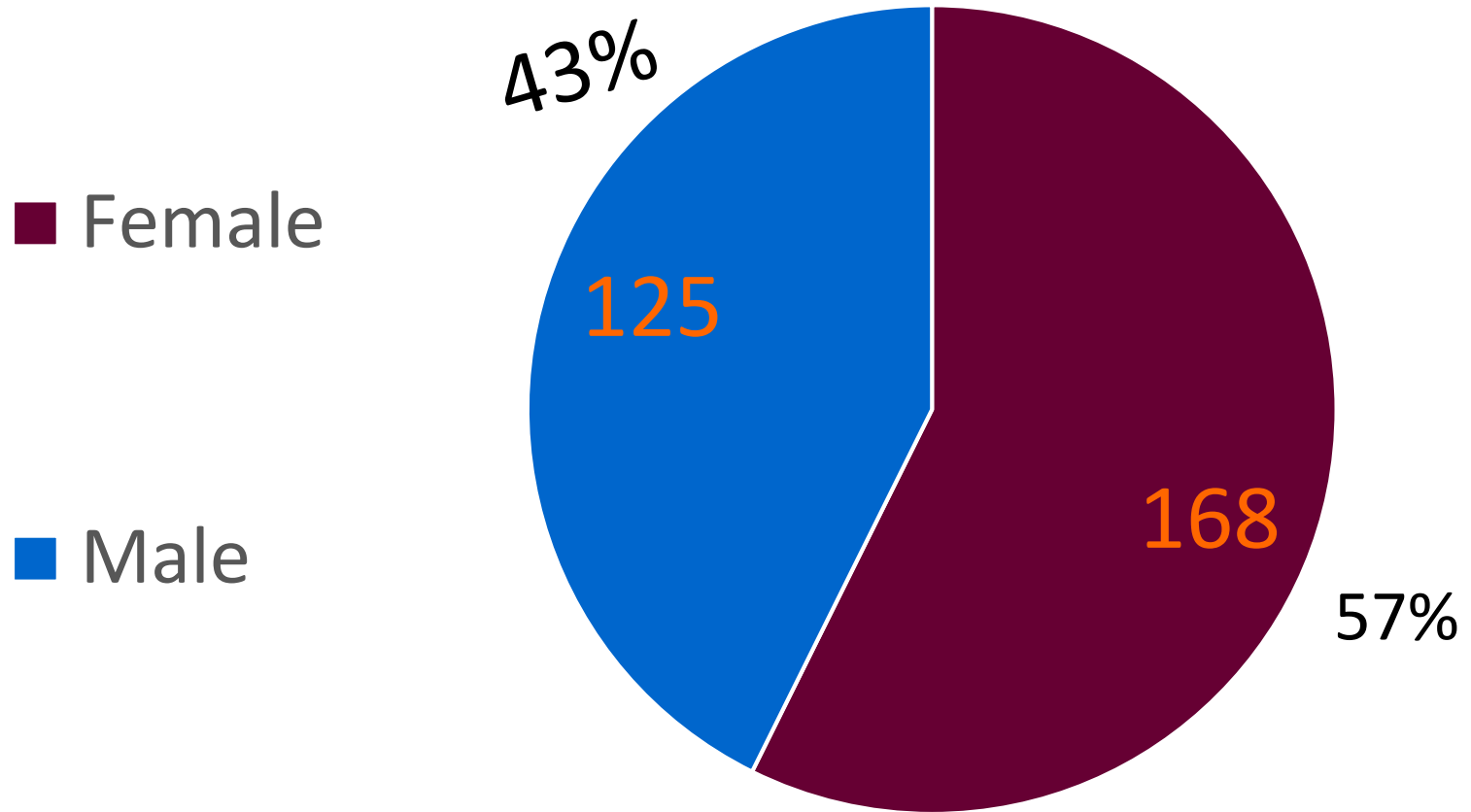
AGE AT DEATH DECEDENTS - COMPARED



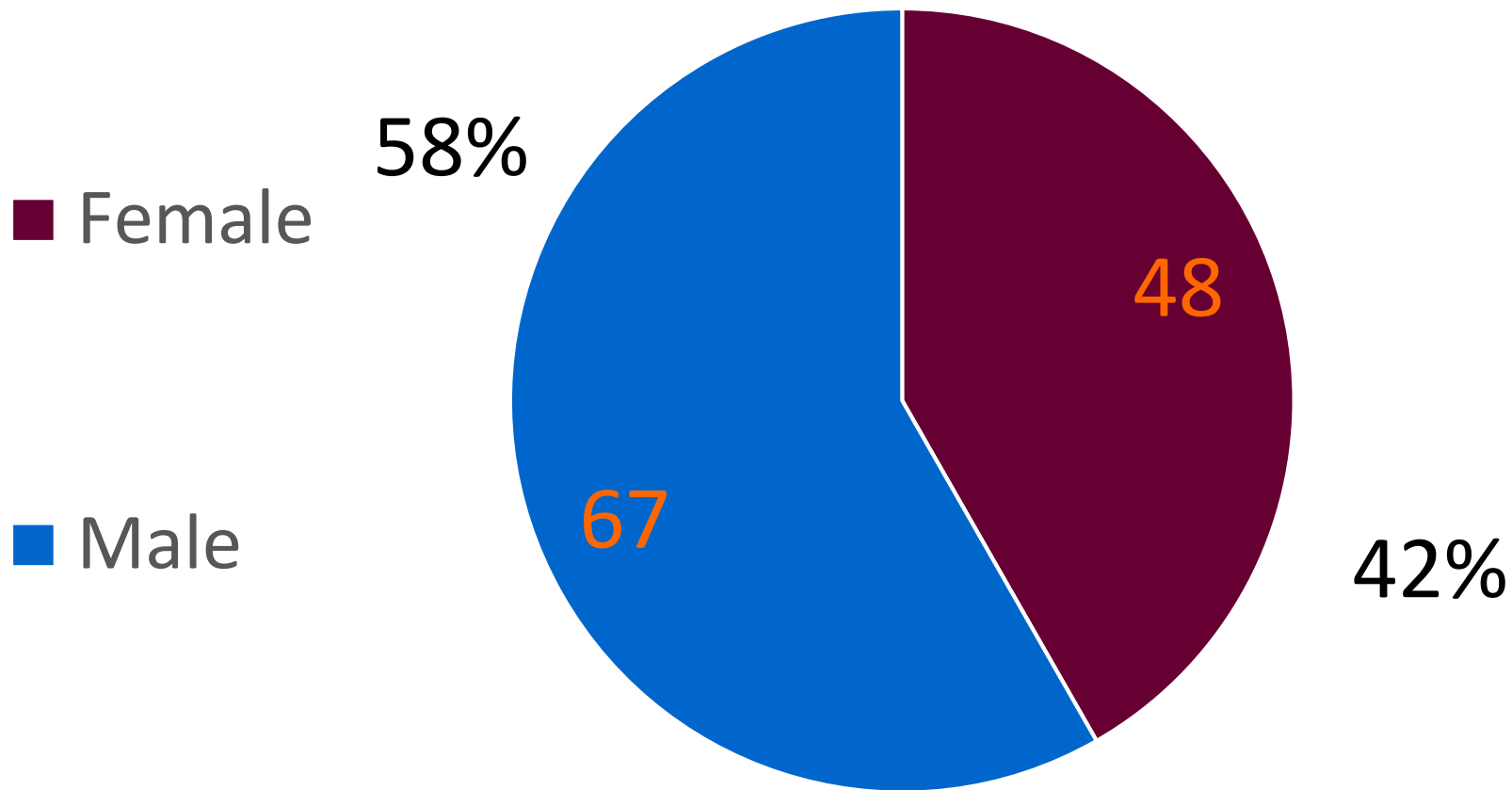

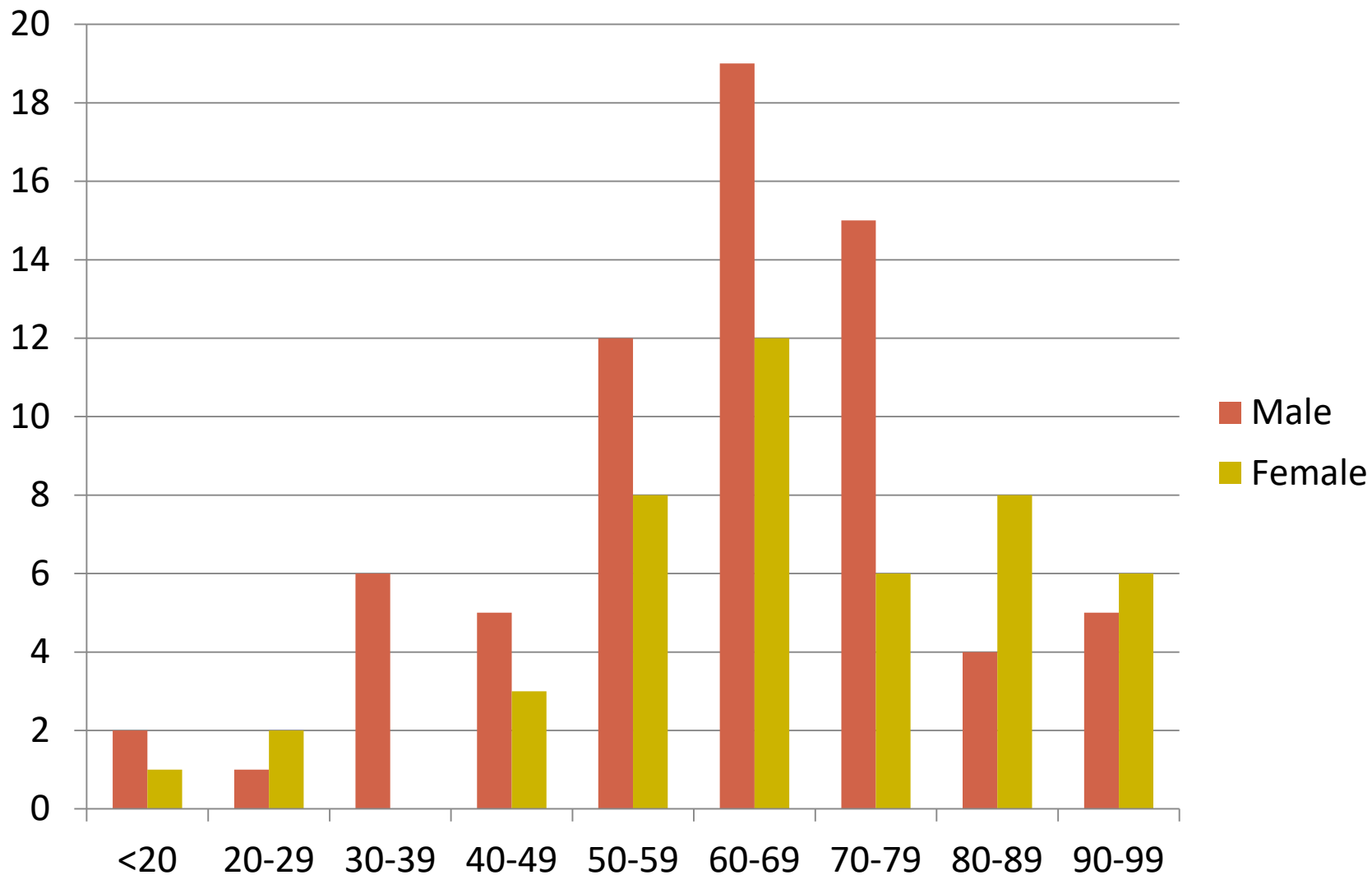

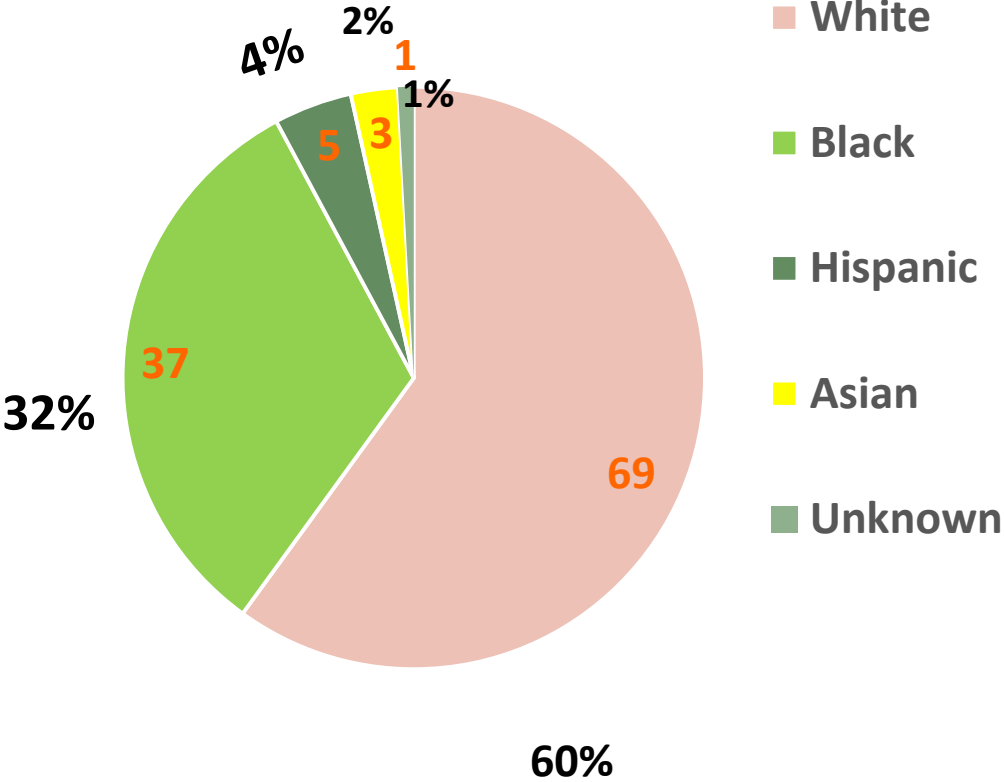

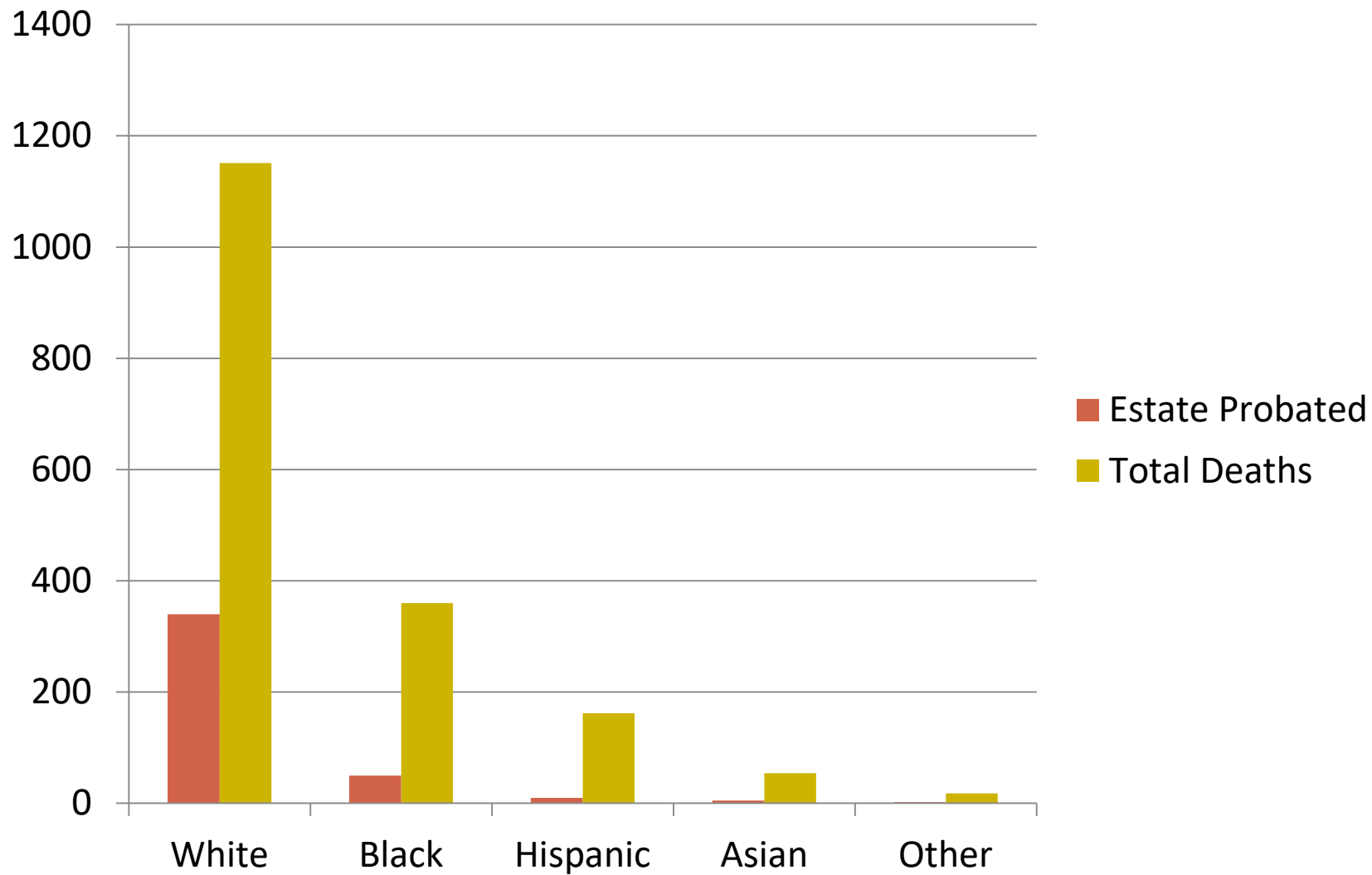

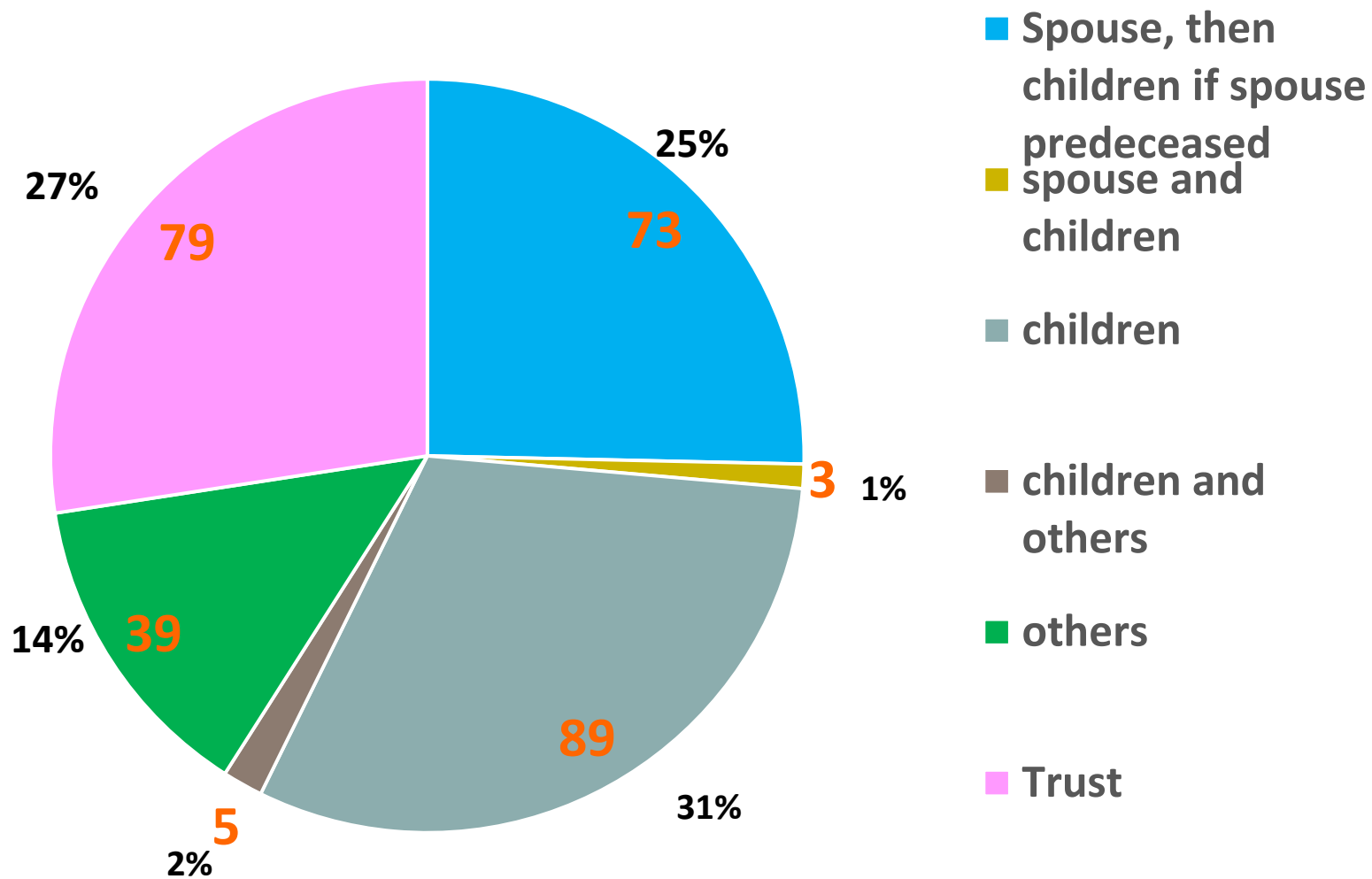

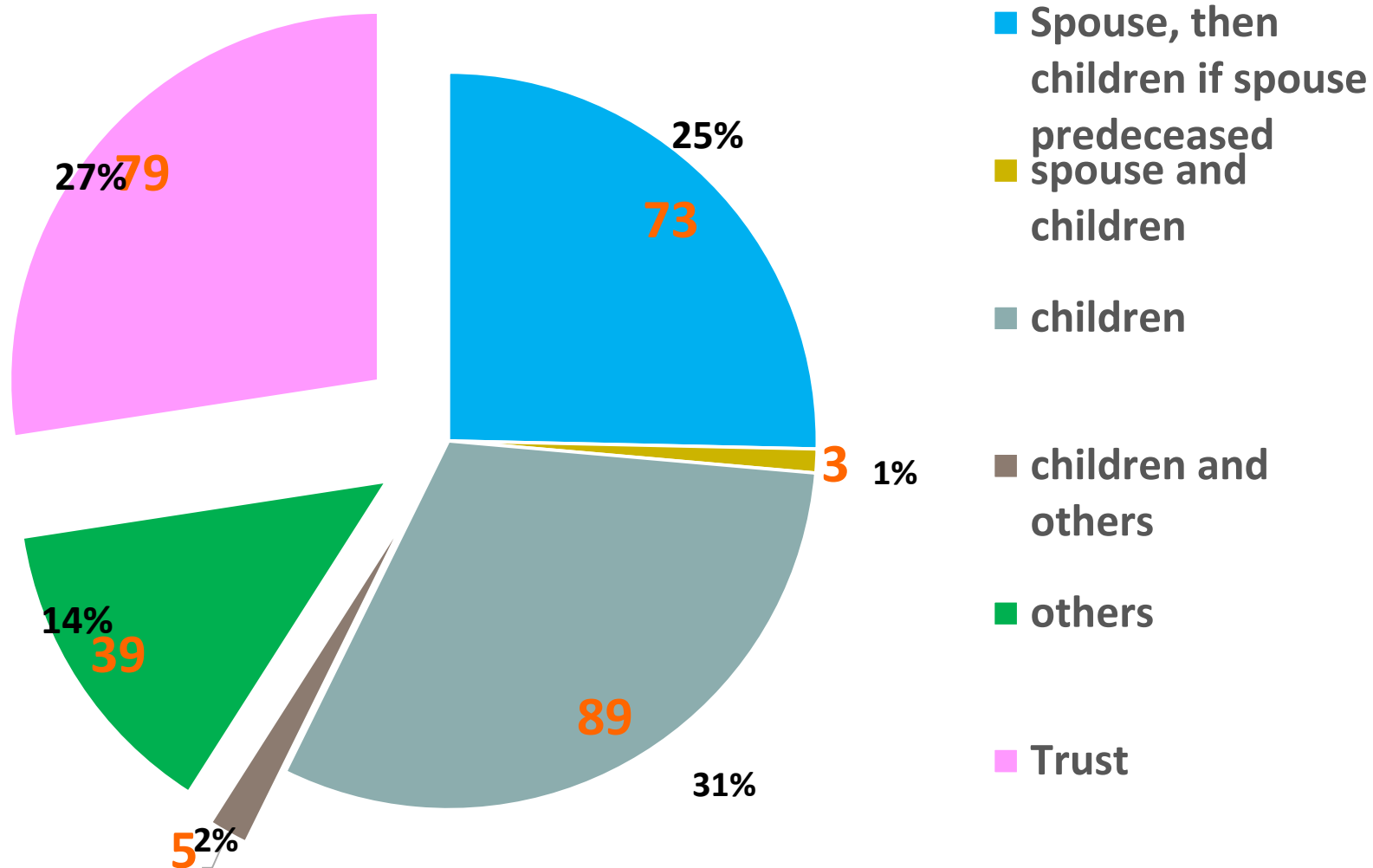
PROBATED DEATHS COMPARED TO TOTAL DEATHS
